Keynote Speaker

Margaret Cornish Principal, Cornish & Co.



Margaret Cornish is principal of Cornish & Co., which provides representational services for Canadian companies with interests in China. She also assists Chinese firms with interests in Canada including board representation. She is a director a Chinese retail company which will shortly be listed on the Toronto Venture Exchange.

Ms. Cornish served as the Executive Director of the Canada China Business Council (CCBC) from 2003-2007. The CCBC is the top bilateral business organization and has been closely involved in the business programs of official state visits. She has worked closely with Chinese and Canadian government on bilateral business policy issues. She currently holds an Associate Fellowship with the Canadian International Council to study the global behaviour of Chinese state-owned enterprises in the resource sector and provide recommendations with respect to treatment of such investment in Canada. She continues to serve as a director of the CCBC.

Ms. Cornish has strong capital markets and international banking experience. She has served on the board of Linamar Inc, the second largest Canadian auto parts company. As a top ranked industrial products analyst at ScotiaCapital (1988-2000) she worked on many IPOs and other financings. Prior to that she led the Scotiabank Sovereign debt restructuring group. She led ScotiaCapital investment missions to China in 1994 and served as the CCBC Advisor on Scotia Investment Missions in 2003-2005.

Ms. Cornish began her career as a commercial officer at the Canadian Embassy in Beijing in 1972. Her undergraduate degree was in Chinese studies and she has an MSc from LSE and an MBA from Toronto. She maintains offices in both Beijing and Cobourg.
